MEMORANDUM FOR FITNESS CENTER PATRONS

SUBJECT: Policy on Appropriate Customer Attire

1. In conjunction with AFI 34-266, *Air Force Fitness and Sports Programs*, appropriate athletic clothing must be conservative and modest in nature while patronizing the Warrior Fitness Center or its running tracks, pavilions and sports fields. Patrons must be mindful that these facilities are on a military installation--professionalism and courtesy for Airmen and their families is expected.

Prohibited Attire:

- a. Clothing containing obscene/offensive language or graphics.
- b. Athletic pants, shorts or shirts must not be sheer to expose undergarments.
- c. Any exposure of midriff area which is defined as the part of the body between the chest and pelvis.
- d. Athletic/spandex shorts must be long enough to extend below the gluteal sulcus (lower buttock region) and cover the entire buttock when sitting, bending or standing.
- e. Casual slacks/shorts and jeans--these articles are considered non-exercise attire.
- f. Court shoes with marking soles on hardwood floors; boots are not authorized on treadmills or hardwood floors.
- g. Garments made of plastic, rubber, nylon, etc. that are specifically designed to increase the amount of perspiration--these garments pose a safety concern, as they increase the risk of heat injury and/or dehydration.

2. In considering your attire choice, common sense and professionalism must prevail. Fitness center staff are authorized to determine acceptable fitness attire. Customers not wearing proper attire will be asked to change into appropriate exercise clothing or leave the facility.
